Re: DVYFC 2010 Davis Competition- Sunday, November 6, 2011 at the U.C. Davis Recreation Pavilion Hall

Information that you should know:

- Parking is \$7.00 per car or SUV. Have the correct change and the line will move faster. Parking is only allowed in parking lot 25, 35, 40 & 41 and the new garage at the NW corner. RV's and busses will be directed where to park. The parking lot does **NOT** open until 7:00 AM. **Please do not arrive early.** You will be cited if you arrive before scheduled time. Please keep the entrance clear for Davis Staff members and Conference Officials.
- Pre-Sell tickets were available for admission through your organization at \$4.50 per ticket. Tickets at the door are \$7.00. You may purchase tickets at the Southeast Concourse level starting at 7:00 AM. An adult **MUST** accompany all children under 15. Everyone over the age of 15 with the exception of **Cheer Coaches, Cheer Coordinators, Mascots and Cheerleaders** (with wrist band and/or badge) otherwise must have a ticket for admission.
- Doors open at 7:45 AM. **(CURLERS must be removed for Mascots, JPW and PW before entering. JM & M after lunch)**
- The main entrance for spectators will be on the Southeast Concourse level. Wheelchair access is available. UC Davis staff will assist with directions to that area.
- Please have all Football Players wear their team Jersey/Shimmel (discourage from attending)
- Cheerleaders are to meet near the Southeast Entrance ramp to the grass field area. Please look for the flag/banner/sign for your city. The cheerleaders will be admitted beginning at 7:15 AM. Make sure all your cheerleaders are there on time. It is important that we begin seating as soon as possible to get the show on the road on time. **ALL SEATED BY 8:30AM**
- SAVING SEATS IS NOT ALLOWED. There will be security personnel to insure that this does not happen. All seating is on a first come first serve basis. There will be no sitting, standing or filming allowed in the aisles.**
- Please sit behind your Cheerleader for Spirit and Support.
- Videotaping area for parents will be in Section 225 & 226. Parents wishing to videotape will be allowed in this section for one performance and then will be escorted out of the area upon completion of that performance. There is no power available or tripods are not allowed. Televisions are not allowed per UC Davis rules and regulations. No sitting, standing or filming allowed in the aisles except for designated Videotaping area.
- Parents are not allowed on the lower level of the Pavilion at any time.
- NO FOOD is allowed to be brought into the Pavilion OR allowed on the performance floor at anytime.** You may enter and exit the building as you wish. There will be a Starbucks and pastries when doors open at 8:00. The snack bars are available from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM for refreshments.
- No tailgating/barbecuing will be allowed on campus or in the parking lot. Picnic lunches are allowed and recommended especially for the cheerleaders as we have only a limited amount of time for lunch break. It is o.k. to picnic on the grass field on the south side of the building. **Please remember to clean up your area after lunch as the UC Davis will assess additional fees for clean up. If garbage is left behind, we as a conference will be changed and in return the conference will charge the cities, so please make sure all garbage is picked up! (NO Practice or Stunting at Lunch)**
- Smoking is allowed in the parking area and 50 feet away from the Southeast Concourse side ONLY.
- Souvenir T-Shirts and other vendor booths selling Cheer accessories up stairs on the North side of the building. The Photographer (Scott Somers) will be providing Group Pictures and New for this year will be Single Portraits for those who would like individual shots of their Cheerleader. The Videographer will be available for souvenir DVD's.
- Don't forget that Spirit Award reflects your spirit for the whole day. So, show your Spirit so your city can WIN the Conference Spirit Award this year. The City Coordinator's vote which city they think has the best spirit for the day.
