**LEAGUE MEETING MINUTES 2-9-10  
MEETING DATE: 3-9-10**

Treasurer Lynn Peyton called the meeting to order at 7:02 P.M.

**ATTENDEES:** Present: President – Bobby McKnight, Vice President - Bob Iwata, Treasurer - Lynn Peyton, Secretary – Shannan Zimmerman, Coaches Commissioner – Jose Zavala. Absent were VP – Dennis Neal and Don DuBois, Coaches Commissioner / Referee Liaison - Dave Jurkiewicz. All 18 cities were present.

**SECRETARY'S MINUTES:** January 12, 2010 minutes were reviewed and M/S/A approved at this meeting.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Lynn presented the treasurers report dated 1/12/10 thru 2/9/10 with an ending balance of \$14,066.17. M/S/A to approve report. \$250.00 Cheer Try-Out fee (If try-outs are held prior to 8/1/10) due at tonight's meeting.

**BUSINESS:**

- **G&N Apparel Presentation** – Nick & Fabian from G&N Apparel did a short presentation regarding their uniforms, pricing, personalized football fundraiser and answered questions. They handed out their business cards to all reps attending this meeting.
- **Introductions** – Everyone introduced themselves.
- **President Meeting Recap** – Bobby went over what was discussed at the presidents meeting held in January. Main topic was cheer. Conclusion, we are keeping cheer and the Davis competition, the board will be adjusting the minimum # as we get closer to the beginning of the season.
- **Referee Issues** – None discussed.
- **DVC Form** – Each city was given a blank form and asked to complete and email to Shannan.
- **Scholar Athlete** – Ceremony will be on 3-18-10, all encouraged to attend. Winners lists were handed out tonight, only 1 disqualification. This is a 2-hour ceremony to include a speaker, pictures and cake. Please double check the spelling of names on the list you were given tonight, bonds & trophies will be made from that list. Presidents should contact winner by mail or phone and congratulate them. Some

cities have a small presentation at their home field during half time to acknowledge the winners within their league during the regular season.

- **Clinic Dates** – Are posted on the website.
- **CPR/1<sup>st</sup> Aid Requirements** – Were handed out at this meeting. Coaches will also receive this same information when applying online.
- **Lottery #'s** – Football lottery #'s were drawn at this meeting, opposite direction of order drawn last year. The #'s drawn are to decide play-offs when there are multiple ties and the seating order at Davis. The #'s drawn and order are as follows: West County #18, SR T-Birds #6, East County #7, Concord #17, West Pitt #16, Benicia #9, San Leandro #10, Martinez #12, Deer Valley #8, Solano #5, American Canyon #13, Pleasant Hill #3, Livermore #11, Antioch #15, Napa #1, Cal Bears #14, Walnut Creek #2, Clayton Valley #4.
- **Player Cards/Physical Cards** – No changes on physical cards, if duplicating yourself they must be EXACTLY like original (on cardstock, same size, same font). Both cards will be available at the March meeting.
- **Cheer** – Outside competitions must be approved, #'s & levels participating in must be emailed to Lynn. If you are conducting try-outs before 8-1-10 you must notify Lynn of location, times and # participating. You must have a complete list of all who try-out available upon request. You are allowed a 3-day camp and a 1-day try-out. In order to be able to stunt, participant must have 10 hours conditioning. Lynn will send out an email to all presidents & cheer coordinators with the above information.
- **Schedules** – Will be posted on the website by the end of next week.
- **Pleasant Hill Resignation** – Roz Rigley has stepped down as president of Pleasant Hill and Wayne Stephens will be the new president.
- **Insurance Certificates** – Jeff Spear (Antioch) requested that cities receive their insurance certificates in July. Bobby stated that we could switch the June & July fees in order to make this happen. This will help all cities get their field permits in a more timely manner. The website will be updated with this change (fee page).
- **City Get Together** – Cities have discussed possibly combining uniform orders (cheer & football) in order to get better pricing. Lynn will organize this meeting and notify cities.
